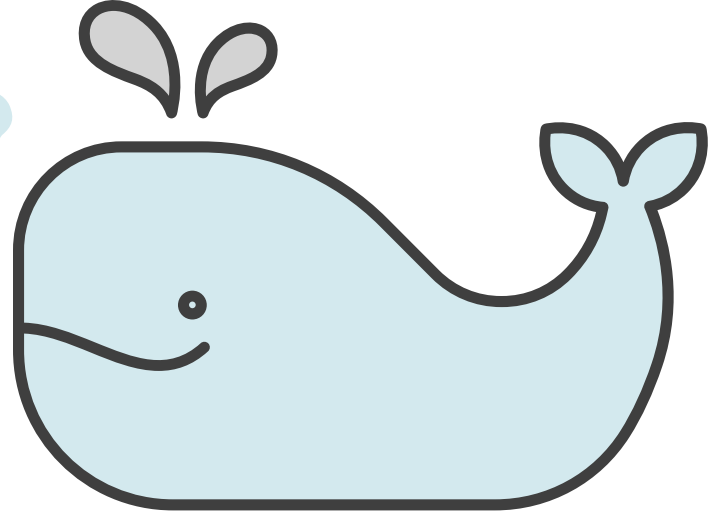

DID YOU KNOW...

PRAY

TUESDAY : JESUS TAUGHT US

“You are the light that gives light to the world. A city that is built on a hill cannot be hidden. And people don’t hide a light under a bowl. They put the light on a lampstand. Then the light shines for all the people in the house. In the same way, you should be a light for other people. Live so that they will see the good things you do. Live so that they will praise your Father in heaven.” Matthew 5:14-16.

QUESTIONS

- What do you think it means to be the light of the world?
- What can you do to be a light for other people?

PRAY

Jesus is the Light of the World! He came into the world to lead us away from darkness (sin) and towards him. Now, thanks to him, we can be saved! Ask God to help you be a light to those around you so that they can know this about Jesus too!



WEDNESDAY :

PEOPLE



In the Bible and throughout history we can learn about lots of people who lived their lives for Jesus. They made mistakes, just like us, but we can learn lots from them!

Today we are going to be learning about a lady called Argula von Grumbach who lived in Germany and was born in 1492.

During her life Argula was the only Christian in her family because at that time it could be dangerous to follow Jesus. Because Argula was married to a rich and important man, she was safe so long as she kept her faith in Jesus a secret. But one day Argula heard about a young Christian who had been unfairly treated by his University. No one was defending him! Because she was a woman, Argula didn't think anyone would listen to her, but she knew she had to do something. She decided to use her wealth and importance to teach the University about Jesus and everything he had done for them, by writing a really long letter!

Everyone made fun of her. They laughed at her, they called her horrible names and they even told her husband to lock her in her room! But Argula knew that these people needed to hear about Jesus. So, even though they treated her horribly, she continued to write. She even used a new invention called the printing press so that even more people could hear about Jesus!

Argula did this for the rest of her life. Because she refused to be quiet about Jesus, she was treated badly by lots of people. But she never stopped – even when she was really old she was kicked out of the palace because she was giving people books about Jesus! Argula knew that she needed to be a light for Jesus and so that's what she was no matter the consequences.

FRIDAY : THE WORLD

In some parts of the world it is really hard and dangerous to be a Christian. These are our brothers and sisters so it's important that we pray for them. Today we are going to pray for our brothers and sisters in Colombia. Do you know where that is?

Colombia is a country in South America. Lots of Christians live in Colombia but it is getting harder to be a follower of Jesus there. Lots of Christians have been working hard to make where they live a better and fairer place. They have been defending poor and vulnerable people and criticising corruption and violence. The people who don't like this are threatening the Christians making it dangerous and very scary to follow Jesus.
