MOSES AND JOSHUA

On Sunday's we're looking at Moses in the Old Testament. Last Sunday we learnt that while the Israelites were in the wilderness, God spoke to Moses face to face. After one year of walking in the wilderness, God took his people to Canaan – the land he had promised to Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob. But did God's people trust him?

The story of Moses and the Israelites can be found in different books of the Old Testament: Exodus, Leviticus, Numbers and Deuteronomy. Lots of these books contain the laws God gave to Moses to help the Israelite's live the way God wanted them too. Can you find Number 13 in your Bible?

Israel had 12 tribes (tribes are like really, really big families). God told Moses to send one man from each tribe into the land he had promised to give them – a place called Canaan. Can you match the spy to the tribe he came from?


Moses gives one of these men a new name. Read verse 16 – what name does he give to Hoshea?

But when the rest of God's people heard about the people who lived in Canaan, they became scared too. They even started to try and convince Moses to take them back to Egypt. Can you read Exodus 14:1-9.

Then God met with Moses in the Tent of Meeting. God was angry with his people. Even though he had done great things for them, they still didn't have faith in him to lead them into Canaan and defeat the people who lived there. Because they did not have faith in him God punished the Israelites.


